Furthermore, if D/O has not been exchanged or the shipment, full or partial, has not been picked up by cnee after normal free time allowed, we will fully be responsible for all charges be involved such as but not limited to container maintenance and repairing, transportation, shifting and necessary operations / liftings in terminal, depot or other suitable storage sites according or not to the instructions of or regulations required by local authorities, costs incurred for total loss of container, all terminal storages / demurrage / detention incurred if any, legal consequences and related charges / costs / penalties, and all freight, administration, operations costs arise due to diversion or return shipment.
